<u>WALKS</u>- Currently we are running three walks a month, all on Monday mornings. The walks are of varying distances and terrain to suit everyone's needs.

First Monday is a short flat walk, in the Porter Valley, usually between Bingham Park and Forge Dam. (Contact Kath B or Gill).

Second Monday walk is approximately 4-5 miles, usually in the Peak District or our immediate local area, and may involve steep gradients and uneven surfaces. (Contact Mavis or Ann C)

Third Monday "Shorter Walk Somewhere" is a 3 to 4 mile walk on relatively flat easy terrain (contact Rosemary or Carol).
